- . Arrange training next to where it will be used



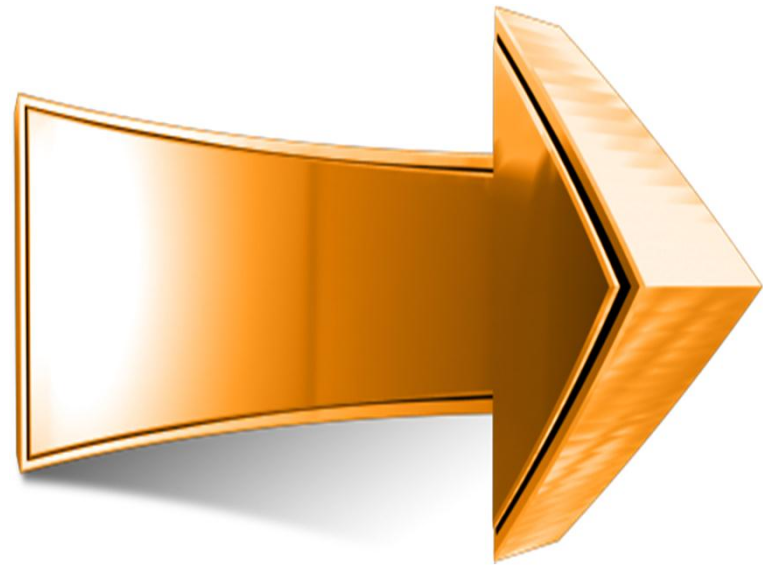
Eliminating Waste

- “ Get rid of anything that doesn't work

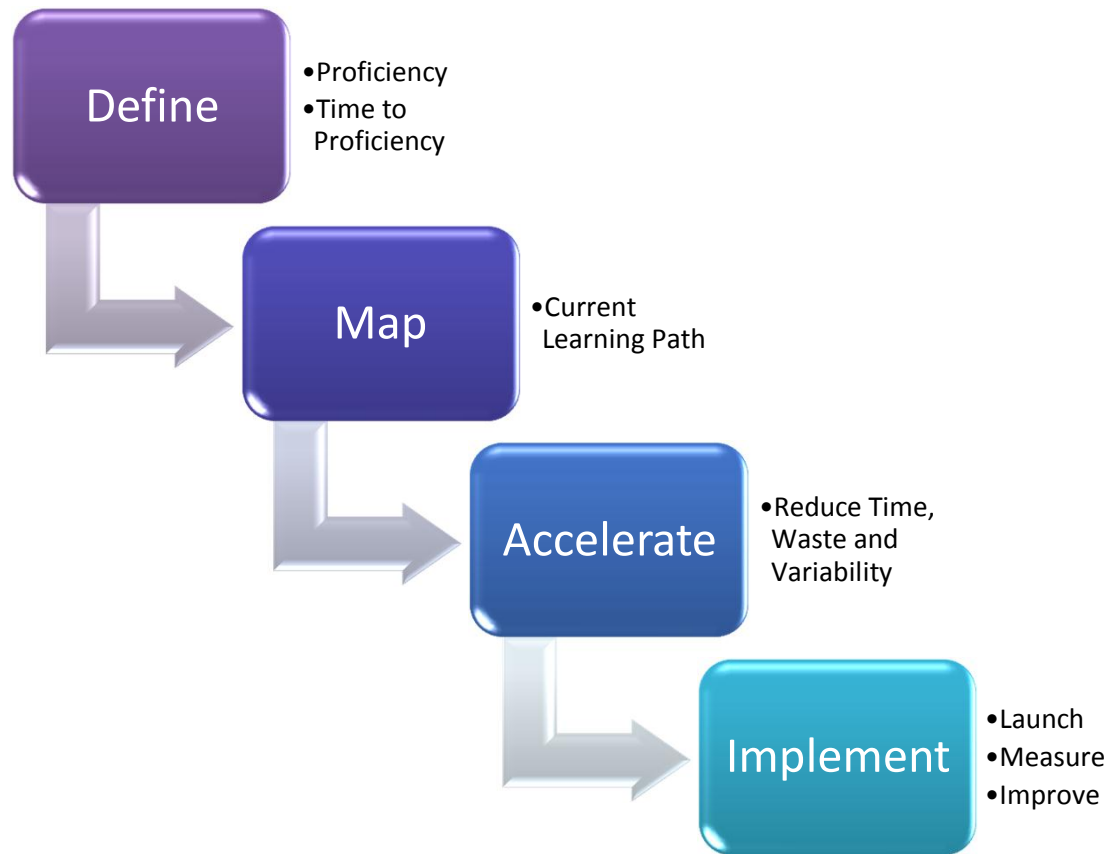


Reduce Variability
